O1: to answer the questions asked by the practicing student by raising his hand

O2: mention at least one stage of work based on supporting material

O3: to use the didactic materials (glue, cotton balls) in the order specified by the practicing student

O4: glue the cotton balls respecting the outline of the snowflake

TEACHING STRATEGY:

b) TEACHING TOOLS: model board, worksheets, cotton balls, glue, polka dots, background music


